Student Achievement Council to hold special meeting Tuesday

OLYMPIA—The Washington Student Achievement Council will hold a special meeting on Tuesday, Sept. 25 at 3 p.m. to consider the selection of officers and other organizational business.

During the special meeting, the nine-member Council, is expected to adopt by-laws and select a Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary. The Council also will discuss the Executive Director recruitment process. By law, the Council must submit to the Governor the names of three candidates for Executive Director. The Governor then appoints the director from among the three.
