## **Health Professional Scholarship Program**

## **Shortage Area Information**

All Health Professional Scholarship recipients must complete their service obligation in a qualified shortage area in Washington State. We strongly advise you to contact program staff prior to accepting employment or when changing employers to assure the employment qualifies for service credit.

If your employment does not meet program requirements, you WILL NOT receive service credit and your conditional scholarship will be placed into default status. All scholarship recipients must be employed in direct primary care and be an employee of the facility.

# **Qualifying Facilities**

### **Eligible Facilities**

- State Correctional Facilities
- State Mental Health Hospitals
- Community and Migrant Health Centers (Federally-Qualified Health Centers)
- Any other facility (public, non-profit, or private) with more than 40 percent of its caseload consisting of Medicaid and has a posted and implemented sliding-fee discount schedule (must meet both conditions)
- Any facility listed in the Shortage Area List for your profession (exceptions listed below)

#### Non-Eligible Facilities -

Examples of facility types that **do not** qualify for service credit (list is for example purposes only and is not inclusive):

- Specialty Clinics (example: facility that treats specific health issues such as diabetes, dialysis, orthopedics, etc)
- Hospital Emergency Departments, Urgent Care Clinics, or Walk-in Clinics
- Urban Hospitals (such as Seattle Children's, Harborview, Tacoma General)
- Placement Agencies working per diem or on a contract for a placement agency

## **Shortage Areas by Profession**

#### **Nursing**

There are no geographic restrictions for practical or registered nurses at this time. You may work anywhere in Washington state. Facility is required to meet Eligible Facilities criteria listed above.

## **Nurse Educators/Faculty**

Must work a full-time equivalent in a combination of faculty and clinical positions. Service credit for teaching undergraduate nursing only, with a minimum of 24 hours a week required at the undergraduate level. Faculty positions must be in a Washington state institution that is experiencing a *critical shortage* of qualified faculty (documentation from the institution must be provided).

#### Other Professions

Shortage Areas for these professions are listed in the following table: Primary Care Physician (MD/DO); Dentist; Registered Dental Hygienist; Pharmacist; Physician Assistant; Nurse Practitioner; Licensed or Certified Nurse Midwife.

HSA's (Shortage areas\*) are based on zip codes surrounding a **core health facility** such as a hospital or local public health department. Examples: Yelm is listed, but clinics in surrounding areas such as McKenna or Roy are included in the service area. Ellensburg is listed but clinics in Kittitas or Vantage are included in the service area.
