**Tier III** includes College of Engineering: Most master and PhD Degrees, School of Nursing: Master of Science and PhD in Nursing Science, School of Public Health: Master of Science and PhD of Public Health, and Master of Science Computing and Software Systems at Tacoma.

**WSU Notes:**

**In Pullman only**, additional fees include Student Recreation Center, Health, Transit, and CUB fee which total \$881 for all groups. Resident and nonresident undergraduates also pay an additional \$50 for the stadium for a total of \$931. **In Spokane only**, the mandatory health fee is \$170.

Master of Business Administration rate is for only the Pullman campus. Students enrolled in the MBA programs at WSU Tri-Cities and WSU Vancouver, as well as students completing the legacy MBA program in Pullman, will continue to pay the regular graduate student tuition rate.

**WWAMI.** Under a memorandum of understanding (MOU) between WSU and UW, students attending the first year of medical school in Seattle, Pullman, or Spokane will pay the same total tuition and enrollment fees. These rates are set by the University of Washington for the medical school. Other mandatory fees are assessed based on the specific campus where the student is enrolled.

**S&A fees** are \$522 for Pullman and Spokane; Vancouver, Tri-Cities and the Global Campus to remain at \$512

**General & Institution Specific Notes:**

**Tuition and fee rates** reflect those reported by institutions.

**CWU** additional mandatory fees include an athletic fee, a recreation center fee, a student health and counseling center fee, a wellness fee, a student lobby fee and a student union fee. The fees are standard across all categories and total \$945 per year.

**EWU** additional mandatory fees include a transportation fee, a recreation center fee, and a comprehensive health and wellness fee. The fees are standard across all categories and total \$161.34 per year.

**TESC** additional mandatory fees include a health services fee, a transit fee, clean energy fee, late night shuttle fee, and CAB building fee. A student taking fifteen credit hours per quarter for 3 quarters would pay about \$678 per year.

**WWU** additional mandatory fees include a health service fee, non-academic building fee, renewable energy fee levied on a per credit basis to a maximum of 10 credit hours per quarter, a student recreation fee and a transportation fee. These fees are standard across all categories and total \$717.75 per year.

**Community college tuition and fee** rates are based on 15 credit hours per quarter for 3 quarters. The tuition figure above reflects the maximum S&A fee. Other fees, including technology fees vary by school.
